We began this group on November 4, 2015. We will pause the group on February 21, 2021. It will remain available for search through March 31, 2021, at which time it will be deleted. (The option to archive no longer exists.)

We've had five great years together in this space. After reviewing the goals we have in Brave Writer and the available resources we have to support those goals, it's become clear to me that managing a group of 17,000 members on the Facebook platform is not serving our best aspirations for community and coaching.

I do see that the group provides a niche value to you and it's that enjoyment of this space that has kept us going. Several of you have come forward to say that you would love to host a group as a Brave Writer fan and user community. To me, that sounds like the ideal next step.

There are a few things to know:

1. Brave Writer is a trademarked name so if you want to create a group for fans, you must say so in the description. For example, you may call it "Brave Schoolers: a Brave Writer Fans Space" or "Brave Writer Fan Group." You can't call it "Brave Writer's Facebook Group" because that implies that it is a Brave Writer sponsored space. Please post below in comments if you'd like to invite members to your newly formed group.
2. You may follow me on Instagram where I share a wealth of user-support including answering questions, re-sharing posts from members who use Brave Writer products, and Instagram Lives to train you. It's entirely free! <https://www.instagram.com/juliebravewriter/>
3. The Brave Learner Home (<https://bravewriter.com/brave-learner-home>) is THE place to get the training and support you crave. With over 7000 members and six coaches participating on the discussion board, you will have a chance to share in ways similar to what you experience here. I realize it is not for everyone, but if you are interested in becoming well equipped to use our program, to enhance your parenting skills and to grow as an adult in your own right, that is where that service is best delivered and supported.
